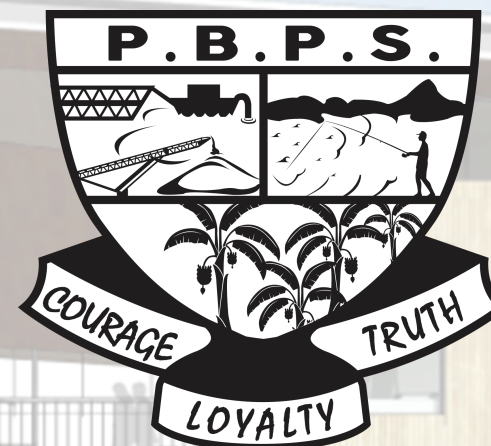

### TEACHER COMMUNICATION

To ensure optimal outcomes for our students we encourage parents to inform teachers of any concerns they may have. ### SEESAW

Stage 2 teachers will be attempting to implement Seesaw in 2021. We are currently learning how to implement this platform and undertaking professional development in this area

SeeSaw is a student-driven digital portfolio that empowers students to independently document what they are learning at school. If you have accessed your child's Seesaw journal in previous years, you may be automatically connected to their 2021 portfolio. If not, a Parent invitation letter with your child's unique code will be sent home in the coming weeks to allow you access to view your child's portfolio.
