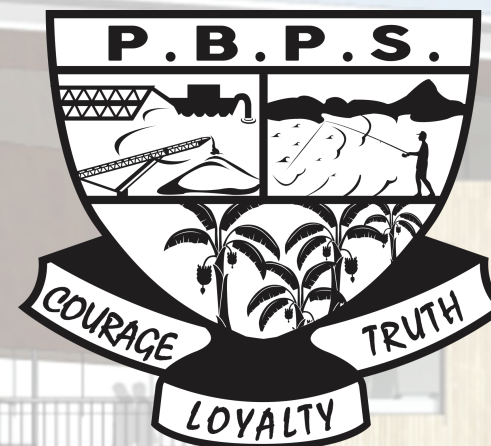
## PE/SPORT

### TEACHER COMMUNICATION

To ensure optimal outcomes for our students we encourage parents to inform teachers of any concerns they may have by calling the school to speak to your child's teacher or arrange an interview. Skoolbag is also another way that we will be communicating all events happening in Stage 3 in 2021. The school newsletter, parent information notes and other messages can all be found here.

SENTRAL Parent Portal is a further avenue for communication. ANY ISSUES that may be affecting your child, need to be expressed to the classroom teacher in the first instance.

### SPORT & PSSA

Stage 3 students will have Sport each Wednesday starting at 9.40am. Students are asked to wear their coloured sports shirts on this day. Hats are also compulsory for sport. There will be opportunities for your child to try out for a PSSA sport throughout the year. Students will need to listen to morning messages given by teachers as this is where the sports will be advertised. PE and fitness sessions will take place twice a week on Mondays and Thursdays. It is important however that students wear footwear appropriate for physical activities every day.

### CAMPS

In Term 4 this year both Year 5 and Year 6 students will be invited to attend a school camp. Details will be provided to parents in Term 3.

### ASSEMBLIES

This term we will be combining our Stage assemblies with Stage 2. This term we have an assembly scheduled for Wednesday of Week 5 at 1.00pm. Then for Terms 2, 3 & 4 we have assemblies scheduled for Weeks 2 and 6, on Wednesdays at 1.00pm. We will let you know when parents are able to attend.

### ABSENCES

By law absences are required to be explained. You can contact the school via the SENTRAL parent portal to explain your child's absence. Late arrivals or early leavers are required to collect a pass from the office.

### TECHNOLOGY

Your child will be provided with a device to access during class time. You are not required to send a device to school with your child. Personal devices (iPads, phones etc) are not required and we ask that these remain at home. If you require your child to have a mobile phone at school, they must take it to the office on arrival for safe keeping and collect before leaving for the day. You can contact your child in an emergency, by calling the front office.

### CRUNCH & SIP

During our morning session students have the opportunity to enjoy a small piece of fresh fruit or vegetable. Nude Food is a concept we are continuing to encourage among our students to support our Waste Wise School initiative.

### CANTEEN

The school canteen is open on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. Orders can be placed into the classroom lunch trays or ordered via Flexischools.

### HOMEWORK

We ask students to engage in a regular home reading to increase fluency, comprehension and vocabulary. From time to time teachers may send home work that has not been completed during class time. Homework projects are assigned from time to time throughout the year.
