Students are asked to wear their sports shirts on a Wednesday. Fitness can occur across the week, so it is advisable to wear sports shoes daily.


## Crunch & Sip

### **Teacher Communication**

Pottsville Beach Public School provides engaging and challenging learning experiences for students in a safe, supportive and inclusive educational environment. Seesaw is the learning app we use to engage students and parents with our teachers in positive partnerships. The school newsletter, parent information notes and other messages can all be found here.

Pottsville Beach Public School will be using School Bytes from the beginning of the 2024 school year for all communication, payments etc. Please ensure you register for the School Bytes parent portal via the QR Code or visit

https://portal.schoolbytes.eduction. Alternatively, you can visit our school's website and select the Make a Payment button – this link will take you directly to School Bytes for registration. We encourage all parents to register as this will be our one stop platform for you to use.



Any concerns or issues that may be affecting your child, need to be expressed to the classroom teacher in the first instance.

#### Absences

By law, absences are required to be explained. Parents will receive a notification from School Bytes if your child is absent from school. Please respond to this notification from School Bytes explaining reason for the absence. Late arrivals or early leavers are required to present to the front office.

### Extended Leave (Travel) Application

In the event that your child will be absent from school for 5 days or more, you are required to submit an application for Extended Leave (Travel). You will need to attach all relevant travel details and the application must be submitted prior to the travel. This application form can be found in School Bytes under Forms.

### Technology

Your child will be provided with a device to access during class time. You are not required to send a device to school with your child. Personal devices (iPads, phones etc) are not required and we ask that these remain at home. *Please do not use Seesaw to communicate urgent messages or changes in your child's* 

*routine, this platform is not intended for this purpose*. It is essential you phone the office in these urgent situations.

### Sport & PSSA

Stage 2 students will have Sport each Wednesday. Students are asked to wear their coloured sports shirts on this day. Hats are also compulsory for sport. There will be opportunities for your child to try out for a PSSA sport throughout the year. Students will need to listen to morning messages given by teachers as this is where the sports will be advertised. PE and fitness sessions including cross country training will take place throughout the week. It is important however that students wear footwear appropriate for physical activity every day and also ensure they have their hat at school every day.

#### Homework

We encourage all students to engage in a regular home reading to increase fluency, comprehension and vocabulary. From time to time, teachers may send home work that has not been completed during class time. Homework projects are also assigned from time to time throughout the year.

### Positive Behaviour for Learning.

Teachers consistently and frequently recognise and reward positive behaviours in the classroom and the playground using our fast and frequent tokens. These tokens are collected at class level and accumulate to achieve whole class awards. These tokens then contribute to whole school rewards. School rewards are chosen by students. Students are also individually rewarded for displaying appropriate behaviour with PBL awards including:

- Star Awards;
- Student of the Week Awards, and
- Safe, Respectful Learner Awards

These awards contribute towards attaining a PBL Gold Award which is distributed at school assemblies. Additionally, 3 students per class are awarded with Safe Respectful Learner medallions at end of year assemblies.
